



To save the water, we're all blessed.

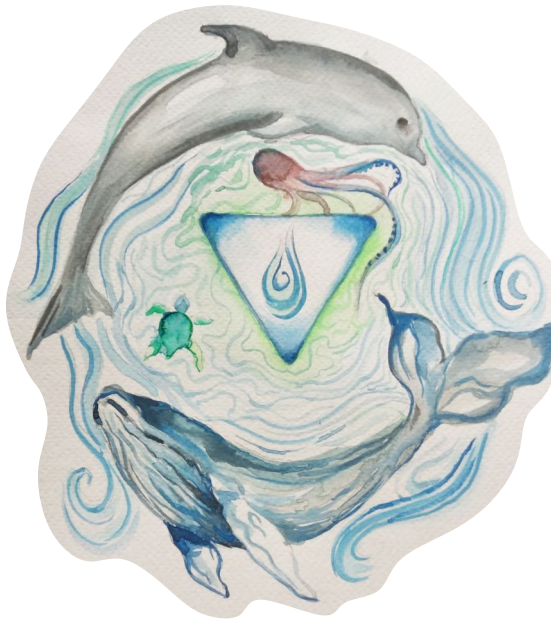


The Big Blue

Water is Life

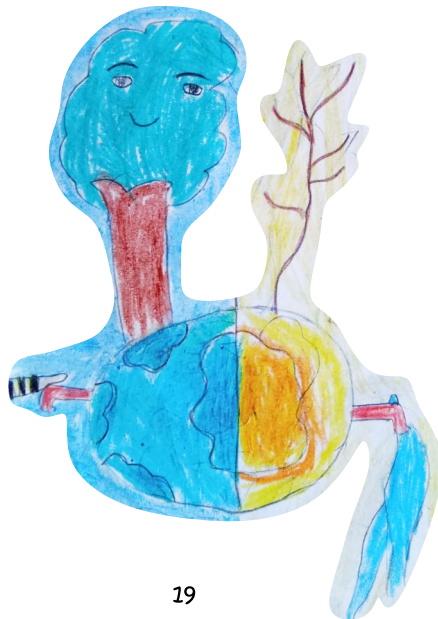


Water is life, it's clear to see

So that we don't have a bitter taste.



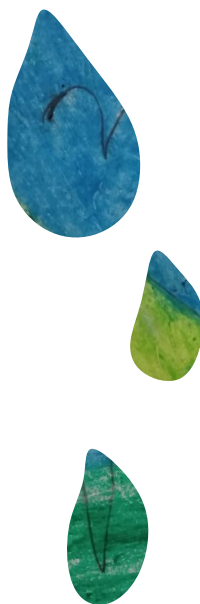
We can turn off the tap when we brush,
