Life with the Sea - A Bajau Story

In the warm waters of Southeast Asia, there lives a unique community called the Bajau – known as the sea nomads. For generations, they have lived Closely with the ocean, travelling by boat, diving deep without equipment, and depending on fish and marine life for survival.

Their deep connection with the sea shapes their culture, language, and lifestyle. But now, their way of life is at risk – from pollution, disappearing coral reefs, and lack of access to education.





Step 1:

17 Goals - 17 Songs

Each team chose one sustainability goal. They had online discussions and shared ideas to understand the issue. Then, together, they wrote songs that explain the goal in a simple and musical way.

Global Youth Explore Waters Together

In a Global Social-network project, Kaulsdorf primary school children explored local water bodies with insights from Indonesia. Guided by freshwater ecologist Janett Trautsch, they investigated streams Saale and Loquitz using sieves and nets to discover aquatic creatures. The project combined hands-on ecology with cultural exchange, raising awareness about water cleanliness and biodiversity.

Step 2: Songs Become Music Videos

Next, these songs were turned into music videos. Each country added its culture, traditions, and colorful visuals to the videos. This made the songs come alive and helped show the beauty of our global teamwork.

Step 3: Drawings by Children

The music and teamwork inspired children to Create drawings. They used colours and shapes to express what they had learned and felt.

These drawings came from deep conversations, new ideas, and global friendships.

Beneath the Waves


Underneath the sea so blue,

Swims so slow and gracefully.


Conservation is our aim,

I'm a big, strong shark in the sea, Conservation is the key. Keep the oceans clean and wide, So sharks can swim with pride.




Manta Ray Melody

To protect the fish, heart and soul.




Mermaid's Lullaby

For a future full of glee.




Fishy Friends

Bubbles in the Sea


Bubbles in the sea go

Cephalopod Celebration


Octopus, squid, and cuttlefish too,

In the ocean's garden, a magical sight, Conservation keeps it bright.


Let's protect the underwater show, So its beauty will forever grow.

Seashells by the seashore, waves crashing in, Conservation is where we begin.


Let's keep the beaches clean and grand,

Conservation is our universe.


Let's protect the reefs so grand,

Tidepool Tango


In the tidepools by the shore,

The Bajau sea nomads

The term "sea nomads" covers a variety of ethnic groups that are native to the island world of Southeast Asia. Their way of life is Characterised by a semi-nomadic existence: During the monsoon season they stay on the islands, but during the rest of the year they move around in boats and live mainly from fishing and other seafood



Grundschule Kaulsdorf / Saale

As part of the Global Social-network initiative, students from Kaulsdorf primary school engaged in a unique exploration of nearby water bodies, enriched by shared knowledge from Indonesia.

Led by freshwater ecologist Janett Trautsch, the Children examined the Saale and Loquitz rivers, using nets and sieves to find and study aquatic life. The project merged environmental science with intercultural learning, encouraging awareness of water conservation and biodiversity.

The enthusiastic participants not only observed tiny river organisms but also exchanged insights with Indonesian students.

This experience fostered environmental understanding and international friendship, highlighting how Curiosity and teamwork Can bridge Cultures through shared learning.

THREATS FACING THE OCEAN

Unsustainable human activities have seriously degraded the ocean.

GLOBAL WARMING

Ocean heat is at record levels and global warming is the culprit.

Why care? Let's break it down.

Unsustainable human activities (primarily the burning of fossil fuels) have dramatically increased greenhouse gases in our atmosphere.

A warmer ocean means:

- Sea level rise
- Shrinking polar ice caps
- Marine heatwaves

Greenhouse gases, such as carbon dioxide. trap the sun's heat in the Earth's atmosphere.

The ocean absorbs more than 90% of the excess heat in the climate system and 25% of all carbon dioxide.

- Extreme weather events
- Coastal flooding & erosion
- Toxic algae
- Ocean acidification

- Job losses
- Livelihoods of coastal communities



Below water

- Dying coral reefs
- Reduced marine biodiversity
