

Together for a Better Future

Writing about poverty is hard—it's real, painful, and unjust. But through the voices of young artists from Hope Theatre Nairobi, who grew up in Kenya's slums, we found a way to speak with hope, not pity. Their rhythm and resilience inspired this book of nursery rhymes on SDG 1: No Poverty.

The verses are simple yet strong, shaped by Children and Communities who live with poverty but also dream beyond it.





Step 1: 17 Goals – 17 Songs

Each team chose one sustainability goal. They had online discussions and shared ideas to understand the issue. Then, together, they wrote songs that explain the goal in a simple and musical way.

17 goals – 17 teams – 17 songs.

At Barnabas Children's Center, the mission is simple but powerful: "Putting a Smile:)". That smile comes not only from food, shelter, and education—but from love. Many children in Kenya face life without the most basic things, but Barnabas works every day to change that, supporting over 500 children in schools and 52 children in their orphanage with care that touches the heart and builds a future.



Step 2: Songs Become Music Videos

Next, these songs were turned into music videos. Each country added its culture, traditions, and colorful visuals to the videos. This made the songs come alive and helped show the beauty of our global teamwork.

Step 3: Drawings by Children

The music and teamwork inspired children to create drawings. They used colours and shapes to express what they had learned and felt.

These drawings came from deep conversations, new ideas, and global friendships.

Step 4: From Drawings to Rhymes

These drawings and ideas inspired Indian Children's writer Suvasri De, who is also a partner of Global Social India.

She wrote 17 nursery rhyme books, one for each goal, using the drawings made by Children from around the world.

Suvasri believes that today's Children need rhymes that talk about real problems in today's world, and real ways to solve them.

The project doesn't end here.

Global Social-network e.V. is working on more exciting projects—

like Children's theatre, storytelling, and educational programs—to keep raising awareness and inspiring young minds everywhere.

Should have rights and dreams and all.


To eat, to sleep, to learn and grow,

So all may rest in safety there.




13. Let Kindness Ring

To lift each other high and high!




16. Lunch Box and Dreams

We help the world leave none behind.




18. Rainbows After Storms

Let's make sure each child can say, "I'm safe and warm today, hooray!"




21. Share the Pie

So every child is warm and fed.




22. Social Plans That Protect

Who dream of chances, just like you.




