This book of nursery rhymes is a celebration of that mission. Inspired by real partnerships—like the one between Erasmus-Reinhold Gymnasium in Saalfeld and the "Florida" school in Samaipata—and global efforts led by organizations like Global Social Network, these poems light up the imagination while planting seeds of awareness.

The rhymes echo the dreams of children learning under solar lights, of families cooking with Clean stoves, and of villages building schools with sun-powered roofs and eco-bricks made by hand.

This is not just a book of poems—it's a book of possibilities.

As young readers sing these verses, we hope they feel empowered. Because every light switched on through Clean energy brings us closer to a fairer, brighter world. And every child who learns to dream green is already powering tomorrow.

Let's flip the switch—together.

Step 1: 17 Goals - 17 Songs

Each team chose one sustainability goal.
They had online discussions and shared ideas to understand the issue. Then, together, they wrote songs that explain the goal in a simple and musical way.

17 goals – 17 teams – 17 songs.

Step 2: Songs Become Music Videos

Next, these songs were turned into music videos. Each country added its culture, traditions, and colorful visuals to the videos. This made the songs come alive and helped show the beauty of our global teamwork.

Step 3: Drawings by Children

The music and teamwork inspired children to Create drawings. They used colours and shapes to express what they had learned and felt.

These drawings came from deep conversations, new ideas, and global friendships.

Step 4: From Drawings to Rhymes

These drawings and ideas inspired Indian children's writer Suvasri De, who is also a partner of Global Social India.

She wrote 17 nursery rhyme books, one for each goal, using the drawings made by Children from around the world.

Suvasri believes that today's Children need rhymes that talk about real problems in today's world, and real ways to solve them.

Windmills dance so happily!




4. Sun on My Roof

Let our kitchen stay fresh and green!




9. Power in the Breeze

Clean and endless, oh so sweet!




10. Night with No Light

So every child can read it all!




11. Energy is Everywhere

Modern stoves are simply divine!




15. Power Heroes

Saving power is our dream.


Close the fridge and shut the light—

We make energy choices right!




16. Grid of Hope

New power's rising from the ground!




24. From Firewood to Future

Turn the dark to learning light!




27. No More Smoke

Deserves a light switch on the wall!




29. Energy Smart

Turn it off when you do not.


Switch off bulbs when rooms are bare,

Electric hope will open doors!




33. The Energy Tree

On the cooperation of the project partners on SDG 7

Samaipata, a town of about 8,000 inhabitants, has been twinned with Saalfeld since 1996. The Erasmus-Reinhold-Gymnasium in Saalfeld maintains a 20-year school partnership with the Gymnasium "Florida" in Samaipata, near Santa Cruz.

As part of this partnership, the Erasmus-Reinhold-Gymnasium supports the Gymnasium 'Florida" through various aid Campaigns. For example, the proceeds from the annual benefit concert, which is organized at Christmas by the Saalfeld Gymnasium, were used for expansion and improvement as well as the purchase of teaching materials at the "Florida" Gymnasium.





The Global Social Network association has taken up this work and integrated the resulting findings into projects in Brazil. These projects are implemented in the Sustainability Center, where natural building materials are used and future plans include renewable energies such as solar energy and biogas. Global Social Network integrates renewable energy insights into worldwide projects.





For example, we help 500 formerly landless people in the Atlantic rainforest of Brazil to build a secure future. Adobe bricks are being used to build a sustainability centre including a school.

Local people learn to make these bricks themselves with biological and local resources in workshops.

Based in Kenya, Barnabas Children's Center is dedicated to caring for orphans and vulnerable children by providing love, education, food, and shelter. With their heartfelt motto "Putting a Smile:)", they currently support over 500 school Children and 52 in their orphanage. Their mission is to meet the holistic needs of each child and help them grow into responsible, empowered adults
