Women work and women lead, Give them what they truly need. Chairs and titles, they can take, Equal pay and no heartbreak!



A world that's kind and truly fair.




Girls Are Stars



Give her a chair, give her a mic, She can lead just who she likes. In the boardroom, on the stage, She can shine at every age.




School Is Cool

Learning math, and making art.


Keep them safe, keep them bright,

Afripads for Schools – Bukomansimbi District, Western Uganda

Led by Sylvia Namukasa and her organization Sylvia Sisters, this initiative supports young girls in Uganda who miss school during their periods due to lack of access to sanitary products. This leads to frequent absenteeism, poor academic performance, and reduced future opportunities compared to boys.



Sylvia takes girls' problems out of the taboo zone!

To tackle this, Sylvia Sisters partnered with a local company near Masaka to develop Afripads—a set of four washable, reusable pads that provide a full year's menstrual care. Each set costs only \$5 and helps ensure a girl can attend school uninterrupted.





With donor support, Sylvia Sisters distributes Afripads to entire schools. The project also aims to raise awareness globally, encouraging similar initiatives in other countries.

To fight stigma and promote awareness, Sylvia Namukasa has also declared an International Menstruation Day.
