Protecting People, Preserving Land

In Brazil's deep forests, once-enslaved Africans formed hidden communities called Quilombos—safe homes where they lived freely and protected nature.

The Quilombolas, as they are known, still live close to the earth—farming, fishing, and passing on traditions. Their bond with the land is deep, but their voices are often unheard.

This rhyme book is inspired by their powerful connection with nature. Thanks to a collaboration between several students from Rudolstadt Germany and Brazilian communities, children explored how life on land can be protected through respect and sustainability.

Step 1:

17 Goals - 17 Songs

Each team chose one sustainability goal. They had online discussions and shared ideas to understand the issue. Then, together, they wrote songs that explain the goal in a simple and musical way.

17 goals – 17 teams – 17 songs. As we learn from their stories, we also follow SDG 15: Life on Land—working to protect forests, wildlife, and our planet. Let's sing, learn, and Care for the Earth—because every tree, every Creature, and every Community counts.



Step 2: Songs Become Music Videos

Next, these songs were turned into music videos. Each country added its culture, traditions, and colorful visuals to the videos. This made the songs come alive and helped show the beauty of our global teamwork.

Step 3: Drawings by Children

The music and teamwork inspired children to Create drawings. They used colours and shapes to express what they had learned and felt.

These drawings came from deep conversations, new ideas, and global friendships.



Step 4: From Drawings to Rhymes

These drawings and ideas inspired Indian children's writer Suvasri De, who is also a partner of Global Social India.

She wrote 17 nursery rhyme books, one for each goal, using the drawings made by Children from around the world.

Suvasri believes that today's Children need rhymes that talk about real problems in today's world, and real ways to solve them.

A fading light.




"Spread the word," The bunny pleads, To save our forests, Plant more seeds..

Making our planet's beauty show.




S.O.S. (Save Our Species)

A treasure we've found.




Shadows of the Tiger

Birds of myriad hues, Soaring in the air, Protect their homes, Show them we care.




Buzzing Harmony

for you and me.


For life depends


