Working Together for a Greener Tomorrow

This rhyme book is inspired by a beautiful story of global friendship and Care for our planet.

Students from Heinrich-Böll Grammar School in Germany and Children from a favela school in Brazil joined hands across continents to protect the environment.

They shared ideas, made eco-friendly items, and raised funds to support rainforest conservation in Brazil.

Step 1:

17 Goals - 17 Songs

Each team chose one sustainability goal. They had online discussions and shared ideas to understand the issue. Then, together, they wrote songs that explain the goal in a simple and musical way.

17 goals – 17 teams – 17 songs. Despite facing poverty, violence, and lack of resources, the Brazilian children learned about nature, planted trees, and discovered hope through music and education. Together, they showed that no matter where we live, we can all take small steps to fight climate change.Let these rhymes encourage every child to become a climate hero!




Step 2: Songs Become Music Videos

Next, these songs were turned into music videos. Each country added its culture, traditions, and colorful visuals to the videos. This made the songs come alive and helped show the beauty of our global teamwork.

Step 3: Drawings by Children

The music and teamwork inspired children to Create drawings. They used colours and shapes to express what they had learned and felt.

These drawings came from deep conversations, new ideas, and global friendships.



Step 4: From Drawings to Rhymes

These drawings and ideas inspired Indian children's writer Suvasri De, who is also a partner of Global Social India.

She wrote 17 nursery rhyme books, one for each goal, using the drawings made by Children from around the world.

Suvasri believes that today's Children need rhymes that talk about real problems in today's world, and real ways to solve them.




Global Social-network e.V. is working on more exciting projects—

Let's keep our Earth safe, for you and me.




The Drought's Cry

Let's save our winters, if we can.




The River's Tale

Melting ices caps - we all care.


Together we'll stand, together we'll fight,

Let's protect our trees, let's think.




The Glacier's Whisper





The Project Partners

"Climate Action" a Captivating nursery rhyme book, springs from international harmony.

Indian poet Suvasri De, inspired by Global Social Brasil's work with kids of the favela in Brazil and School children of Heinrich-Böll-Gymnasium, crafts verses echoing their concern for climate change,



Heinrich-Böll-Grammar School in Saalfeld



Ms. Steffi Schramm, teacher at Heinrich-Böll-Grammar School in Saalfeld, had a cultural exchange with some interested students of grades 5-9 via the Internet with the Visao Secondary School in a favela in Salvador de Bahia/Brazil on the sustainability goal SDG 13 - climate protection measures. In the run-up to the campaign, German students sewed patchwork rag bags and sold them for their friends in Brazil, the children from the favela, in order to save the rainforest.

Global Social Brazil, together with the Capoeira group and favela children from Salvador de Bahia, want to reforest the Atlantic rainforest in Brazil, as it is very important for the Brazilian and the world climate.

The children and young people were in the Mato Atlantica rainforest region and planted tropical trees there for a week and trained Capoeira.

They then planted trees that were financed by the Böllians through their rag bag campaign.




